**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has recommended that City Council approve the City’s acceptance of the State appropriated funds for the Real Time Crime Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Planning and Development has recommended that City Council approve the City’s acceptance of the State appropriated funds for the park improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, Council deems it necessary and appropriate to authorize the Wilmington Police Department to accept the appropriated State funds and proceed with the implementation of the Real Time Crime Center; and

**WHEREAS**, Council deems it necessary and appropriate to authorize the Department of Planning and Development to accept the appropriated State funds and proceed with the park improvements.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON** that the Wilmington Police Department is hereby authorized to accept the \$750,000.00 appropriated by the Delaware General Assembly pursuant to Senate

Bill 160 (the Fiscal Year 2016 Bond and Capital Improvements Act) and take all necessary actions to accept the appropriated funds and implement the Real Time Crime Center.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Department of Planning and Development is hereby authorized to accept the \$500,000.00 appropriated by the Delaware General Assembly pursuant to Senate Bill 160 (the Fiscal Year 2016 Bond and Capital Improvements Act) and to take all necessary actions to accept the appropriated funds and proceed with the park improvements.
