**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 2-363 of the Code of the City of Wilmington (“City”), the City may apply for and receive grant funds to be used for a wide variety of City activities, subject to the approval of City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City, through the Wilmington Police Department (“Department”), has sought to obtain grant funding from the State of Delaware, Special Law Enforcement Assistance Fund (S.L.E.A.F.) in the amount of \$28,500.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed grant funds will be utilized to purchase a PADtrax evidence tracking system to be used in the Department’s evidence safe, which holds all non-drug evidence utilized for prosecutions; and

**WHEREAS**, the S.L.E.A.F. grant does not require a local or “in kind” match; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council deems it necessary and proper to authorize the Wilmington Police Department to accept the grant funds from the S.L.E.A.F. in the amount of \$28,500.00, for the aforesaid purposes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON** that the Wilmington Police Department is hereby authorized to accept grant funding from the State of Delaware, Special Law Enforcement Assistance Fund in the amount of \$28,500.00.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief of Police of the Wilmington Police Department, or his designee, shall be authorized to take all necessary actions to accept and administer the grant funds.
