

**AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT A CAPITAL BUDGET
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Wilm. C. (Charter) Sections 2-203, 5-600 and 5-601, the Mayor has submitted to the Council of the City of Wilmington the six-year Capital Program with recommendations of the City Planning Commission and, consistent with that Capital Program, set forth therein is the Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 2017, which is consistent with the Capital Program for Fiscal Years 2017-2022, reviewed and recommended by the City Planning Commission at its regular meeting held on March 15, 2016, by its Resolution 5-16; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SECTION 1. A Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 2017 in the amount of \$0 is hereby adopted and approved as set forth under the column entitled "Fiscal Year 2017" in the "Capital Improvements Program and Capital Budget for Fiscal Years 2017-2022," consistent with the City's two-year spending plan in which alternating years are zero dollar years.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its date of passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
