THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 2 of the City Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined

language as follows:

Sec. 2-671.1. Audit Review Committee

- (b) Membership. The Audit Review Committee shall consist of the following <u>five (5)</u> <u>voting members:</u>
  - i. Chairperson Member of the public, appointed by the Mayor
  - ii. City Council Finance Committee Chair or his/her designee who shall be a member of City Council
  - iii. Chief of Staff Mayor's Office
  - iv. Member of the public, appointed by the City Council President
  - v. Member of the public, appointed by the City Council President

The City Council Chief Financial Officer shall serve as a non-voting member of the Audit Review Committee.

**SECTION 2**. This Ordinance shall become effective on April 1, 2017.
