**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 42 OF THE CITY CODE REGARDING THE MOBILE FOOD VENDING UNIT PILOT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council deems it necessary and appropriate to amend Chapter 42 of the City Code to alter the current provisions contained therein to account for the startup time required for the Mobile Food Vending Unit Pilot Program to be implemented and to account for the timing of such implementation which occurred during a season where demand for access to a Mobile Food Vending Unit is less.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON HEREBY ORDAINS:**

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 42 of the City Code is hereby amended by deleting the language that has been stricken through and by adding the underlined language to Section 801 so that it reads as follows:

- (a) This mobile food vending unit pilot program and sections 42-801 through 42-817 shall be effective as of the date of passage by city council and approval by the mayor and shall have a duration ending on ~~June~~ September 30, 2016.

**SECTION 2.** Effective date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its date of passage by the City Council and approval of the Mayor.

**Synopsis:** This Ordinance amends Chapter 42 of the City Code and extends the time period for the Mobile Food Vending Unit Pilot Program from an end date of June 30, 2016 to September 30, 2016 to account for the Program’s implementation at a time of the year where the demand for Mobile Food Vending Units is less due to the weather conditions and which leads to a lack of availability of data that could be used measure the program’s effectiveness.
