AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 42 OF THE CITY CODE REGARDING THE MOBILE FOOD VENDING UNIT PILOT PROGRAM

Council Member Williams WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary and appropriate to amend Chapter 42 of the City Code to alter the current provisions contained therein to amend the statutory scheme under which the Mobile Food Vending Unit Pilot Program was operating to change the Program from a temporary pilot program to a permanent implementation,.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The title of Chapter XIV of Chapter 42 is hereby amended by deleting the language that has been stricken through and by adding the underlined language so that it reads as follows:

'ARTICLE XIV. - MOBILE FOOD VENDING UNIT PILOT PROGRAM'

SECTION 2. Chapter 42 of the City Code is hereby amended by deleting the language that has been stricken through and by adding the underlined language to Section 801 so that it reads as follows:

(a) This mobile food vending unit pilot program and sections 42-801 through 42-817 shall be effective as of the date of passage by city council and approval by the mayor and shall have a duration ending on September 30, 2016.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its date of passage by the City Council and approval of the Mayor.
