Council Member Turner **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 2-308 and Section 8-200 of the City Charter, City Council may, by Ordinance, authorize contracts for the rendering of services for a period of more than one year; and

WHEREAS, the City publicly advertised the specifications for Contract 18024PW – Mineral Aggregates ("the Contract") – in accordance with the requirements of Section 8-200 of the City Charter, and subsequently awarded the Contract, a copy of which, in substantial form, is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein as Exhibit "A", to Penn/MD Materials, Div. of H&K Group, Inc. (the "Contractor"), the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the term of the Contract is for a period of two (2) years from on or about July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019, at an estimated price of \$54,578.00 per year for a total price of \$109,156.00, with the possibility of two, one-year extensions thereafter with the same terms and conditions, at the option of the City, subject to budget appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the Contract is to provide construction materials such as crushed stone to the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, said extension periods were included in the Contract in order to provide for continuity of service; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Department of Public Works that the City enter into the Contract with the Contractor for a period of Two (2) years, i.e., from on or about July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019, and reserve the right to extend the Contract for two (2) additional periods of one (1) year thereafter, at the option of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Contract 18024PW – Mineral Aggregates - between the City of Wilmington and Penn/MD Materials, Div. of H&K Group, Inc., a copy of which Contract is attached hereto as Exhibit "A," for the period of two (2) years from on or about July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019, at an estimated price of \$54,578.00 per year for a total price of \$109,156.00 with the possibility of two (2) additional extensions of one (1) year thereafter with the same terms and conditions, at the option of the City, is hereby approved, and the Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute as many copies of the Contract, as well as all additional undertakings related thereto, as may be necessary.

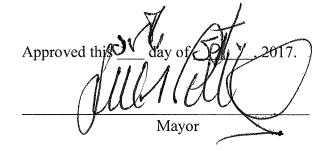

- 2. Proposals must be in triplicate, sealed in an envelope, and the envelope endorsed "Bid for City Contract 18024PW MINERAL AGGREGATES" and addressed to the Department of Finance, Division of Procurement and Records, 5th Floor, Louis L. Redding City/County Building, 800 French Street, Wilmington, Delaware.
- 3. Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the schedule time for opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof. No bid may be withdrawn within thirty (30) calendar days after the actual opening thereof.
