WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 125 included provisions establishing a working group to determine the feasibility of developing Canby Park in the 6<sup>th</sup> District of the City of Wilmington or other locations in Wilmington suitable for the purpose of providing sports and recreational facilities to St. Elizabeth High School and Howard High School; and

WHEREAS, the working group currently consists of various stakeholders, including individuals representing the General Assembly, the State of Delaware, New Castle County and the City of Wilmington; and

WHEREAS, although the City of Wilmington has appointments on the working group from the Administration and the Treasurer's Office, the Council Member from the host district is not included; and

WHEREAS, the inclusion of the Council Member from the host district would bring to the working group a wealth of knowledge regarding the district and those who reside there, which would be of value to the group and aid in its success; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wilmington City Council respectfully recommends that the General Assembly amend Senate Bill No. 125 to include the 6<sup>th</sup> District Council Member as a permanent member of the working group.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON, that the Council respectfully requests that the 6<sup>th</sup> District Council Member be included as a permanent member of the working group created by the passage of

Senate Bill No. 125. The inclusion of the 6<sup>th</sup> District Council Member would ensure that the best interests of the community are kept in mind by the working group in determining the feasibility of developing Canby Park.
