AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT CERTAIN PARKING REGULATIONS

Council Members Shabazz Freel WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter and Chapter 37 of the City Code, the Department of Public Works has proposed and the City Council deems it necessary and proper to enact the parking regulation set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That "NO PARKING BUS STOP BETWEEN SIGNS" signs be installed at the following locations"

- a. On the westside of North Dupont Street beginning 5 feet from the northerly curb line of West 16th Street and extending north 64 feet.
- b. On the eastside of North Walnut Street beginning 105 feet south of the southerly building line of East 8th Street and extending south 60 feet.
- c. On the eastside of North Walnut Street beginning 43 feet from the southerly building line of East 10th Street and extending south 80 feet.

SECTION 2. That a "**Bus Stop**" sign be erected on the southeast corner of North Clayton Street and intersecting with Delaware Avenue.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its date of passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
