WHEREAS, Section 2-101 of the City Charter and Section 2-34 of the Wilmington City Code set forth the process for filling a vacant City Council position between general election; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter requires that the City Council choose a candidate by majority vote to fill the vacant City Council position; and

WHEREAS, City Council deems a special election to fill the vacancy in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Wilmington, allowing voters to choose the best candidate able to represent their district; and

WHEREAS, a council vacancy with a remaining unexpired term exceeding 180 days from the date of the vacancy should result in a special election to elect a duly qualified successor to serve the remainder of the unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware General Assembly has the authority to amend the City Charter by a two-thirds vote in order to require that a special election be held when a City Council position becomes vacant between general elections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE

CITY OF WILMINGTON, that the City Council encourages the Delaware General Assembly to amend the Charter of the City of Wilmington to allow for a special election in the event that a position on City Council becomes vacant between the general elections.
