#4614 Ord. 19-001 Amend Chapter 2 of the City Code Regarding Procedures to Fill City Council Vacancies (**3rd & Final Reading**)

Synopsis: *This Ordinance is being presented by City Council for Council's review and approval. This Ordinance amends Section 2-34 of the City Code, which set forth procedures to fill City Council vacancy, by allowing all members of Council to be part of the committee that recommends to Council an individual to fill a Council vacancy.*

#4610 Ord. 18-056 Amend Chapter 5 of the City Code Regarding Businesses (**3rd & Final Reading**)

Synopsis: *This Ordinance is being presented by City Council for Council's review and approval. This Ordinance amends Chapter 5 of the City Code requiring businesses that sell tobacco products, electronic smoking devices, or tobacco paraphernalia to place such items behind a counter in an area that is not accessible to customers without the intervention of an employee of the business so as not to be placed within the reach of children.*

#4615 A Resolution Calling on the General Assembly to Enact Legislation Authorizing the City of Wilmington to Adopt a Nonpartisan Primary Election System

Synopsis: *This Resolution is being presented by City Council for Council's review and approval. This Resolution urges the Delaware General Assembly to enact legislation authorizing Wilmington City Council to adopt a more comprehensive, nonpartisan primary election system to ensure inclusive and democratic elections for City officials.*

#4613 A Resolution to Fill the Vacancy in the First City Council District
