CUSTODIAL RESOLUTION

FOR TRANSFER OF CERTAIN LANDS
FROM
THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
TO
THE CITY OF WILMINGTON

This Custodial Resolution is made and entered into as of this ____ day of ____ 2019, by and between the **State of Delaware**, **Department of Transportation** (hereinafter referred to as "**DelDOT**"), a Delaware state agency, and the **City of Wilmington** (hereinafter referred to as "**City**"), a Delaware governmental entity.

WHEREAS, DELDOT is responsible for a tract of land identified as Excess Public Right of Way in the State of Delaware, as identified on the attached Exhibit A (hereinafter "DelDOT's Land"); and

WHEREAS, DelDOT's Land is situate in the City of Wilmington, New Castle County and State of Delaware which lands were acquired for transportation purposes which, as of the date of this Custodial Resolution, are not presently required for a transportation project; and

WHEREAS, DelDOT has agreed to convey to the City said lands described on Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, for the public purpose of a skate park recreation facility open to the public; and

WHEREAS, DelDOT believes that such conveyance can occur while still retaining such lands that will meet DelDOT's transportation needs; and

WHEREAS, DelDOT has no present or future plans for the utilization of the portion of DelDOT's Land to be conveyed to the City; and

WHEREAS, this conveyance is made in accordance with the provisions set forth in 17 Del.C. §137(b)(7).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) paid from the City to DelDOT, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, DelDOT hereby surrenders and transfers to the City any and all of its custodial interests in that portion of DelDOT's Land, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The transfer is subject to all matters of record to the extent such matters are valid and enforceable.
- 2. Any existing easements or rights-of-way for utilities will transfer with the Custodial Resolution and will be accepted by the City.
- 3. The City shall assume all responsibilities and liabilities for all matters arising following the transfer of custody of that portion of DelDOT's Land described herein to the City.
- 4. **Restrictions on Use:** In order to accomplish, safeguard, and promote the purposes of this Custodial Resolution, DelDOT, in consultation with the City, hereby declares and covenants that the following restrictions are hereby imposed and shall apply forever in that portion of DelDOT Land to be transferred:
 - (a) In the event that the City does not commence construction activities for a skate park recreation facility on or before ______, then all rights to the DelDOT Land, including possession and use, shall revert back to DelDOT. In that event, the City agrees to cooperate by all means reasonably necessary to accomplish said reversion of the DelDOT Land to DelDOT including, but not limited to, execution of any and all documents necessary to accomplish said reversion.
 - (b) Any building, structure, improvement, or facility to be constructed on the DelDOT Land shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, codes, and/or ordinances.
 - (c) No dumping, depositing, abandoning, discharging, or releasing of any gaseous, liquid, solid, or hazardous waste, substances, materials of whatever nature on, in, over or under the site or into surface or ground water of the site shall occur, except as permitted and required by law.
- 5. Permitted Uses: DelDOT and the City hereby declare and covenant that a skate park recreation facility maintained by or on behalf of the City shall be the only use permitted on the DelDOT Land, subject to the limitations contained herein, and this requirement and restriction shall apply forever to the use and enjoyment of the site. In the event that the City shall ever, at any time, convey its interests in the premises to any other entity or permit the premises to be used in a manner inconsistent with this Custodial Resolution, then all rights to the DelDOT Land, including possession and use, shall revert back to DelDOT. In that event, the City agrees to cooperate by all means reasonably necessary to accomplish said reversion of the DelDOT Land to DelDOT including, but not limited to, execution of any and all documents necessary to accomplish said reversion.
 - (a) Skate park recreation facilities open to the public.

6. Review Process: Should the City plan any ground disturbing activity which is not covered by the Permitted Uses defined above, the the City shall consult with the Delaware State Historic Preservation Office (hereinafter referred to as "SHPO"), and DelDOT prior to proceeding with any such work. SHPO may require changes to the location, methods, materials, and/or extent of such work, and/or may require the City conduct an archaeological survey to first determine the presence of any archaeological sites. If an archaeological survey is required, the review process shall be carried out in a manner in keeping with the steps defined by the implementing regulations (36 CFR Part 800) of Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C Part 470). All archaeological work must meet federal and state standards and guidelines, and must be carried out by or under the direct supervision of persons meeting or exceeding the Secretary of the Interior's Professional Qualifications for archaeology. DelDOT shall participate in the review process.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED SKATE PARK

PORTION OF LAND LOCATED IN THE I-95 RIGHT OF WAY

CITY OF WILMINGTON, DELAWARE

BEGINNING at the intersection of the southwesterly right of way of Lower Linden Street, a 35 foot wide right of way, and the southeasterly right of way of Liberty Street, a 40 foot wide right of way, said intersection being a distant North 63°00'37" East 17.50 feet to a point in the center line of Lower Linden Street and North 26°59'23" West 269.58 feet to the centerline monument found in the intersection of Maryland Avenue, a 64.5 foot wide right of way, and said Lower Linden Street; thence following said southwesterly right of way line of Lower Linden Street and having a meridian reference to the State of Delaware Grid North American Datum 83/91, as now surveyed:

- 1) South 26°59'23" East 151.33 feet to the southeasterly corner of Parcel Two, as shown on a Record Major Subdivision Plan, titled "Reybold Venture Group XVII, L.L.C.", dated June 24, 2002 and recorded in the Office of the Recorder in New Castle County, Delaware as Instrument Number 20031031-0139425, said southeasterly corner being the beginning of an arc having a radius of 1,560.00 feet, said arc also being the northwesterly right of way line of AMTRAK; thence along said arc,
- 2) Southwesterly 146.89 feet, concave southeasterly, having a radius of 1,560.00 feet and subtended by a chord of South 46°56'47" West 146.84 feet to a line 25.00 feet southeasterly from the fascia of the I-95 ramp; thence crossing through the I-95 right of way to create a new line of division and being 25.00 feet from the I-95 ramp fascia as now surveyed the following 5 courses:
- 3) Northerly 36.87 feet along an arc concave to the west, having a radius of 1,525.00 feet and subtended by a chord of North 02°02'36" East 36.87 feet;
- 4) North 01°21'02" East 28.23 feet to a point on the northwesterly line of said Parcel Two, said point being distant South 62°58'40" West 30.65 feet and South 46°12'37" West 90.75 feet to an open iron pipe found at the end of the North 38°48'02" East 668.64 foot line shown on said Record Major Subdivision Plan; thence continuing
- 5) North 01°21'02" East 36.79 feet;
- 6) North 00°06'11" West 69.46 feet;
- 7) North 00°12'50" West 13.27 feet;



- 8) North 05°04'36" East 34.43 feet to said southeasterly right of way of Liberty Street; thence along said southeasterly right of way line
- 9) North 63°46'25" East 36.68 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

CONTAINING 14,152 square feet or 0.3249 of an acre of land, more or less.
