

2019 - 2020 Scholarship Information

General Fresh Start Information:

- Statewide organization with an all-volunteer board
- Started in 1996 by Wilmington Women in Business the founding President, Mary Maloney, served as President for the first 17 years and remains on our board today
- The only criteria for applying: they must live or work in Delaware and attend a Delaware College, have a gap in their education (i.e. did not go to college directly out of high school or dropped out after starting), be at least 20 years old, and have a financial need for tuition assistance
- Each scholar has a mentor to help guide her through the rough patches and to help with networking for internships and employment
- We consider a number of factors in deciding on the scholarship funding amounts for each woman
 including their financial situation (most of our scholars are considered low-income or very low
 income), the cost per credit at the school they are attending, and how many credit hours they will be
 taking each semester
- Have 12 Advisory Board members community leaders willing to lend their expertise
- Have given 555 scholarships (to 248 individuals) totaling over \$1.1 million
- 141 graduates to date with a graduation rate of 70.85% (this does not include those who dropped out for health reasons or died before graduating or those we denied re-application)

2019-2020 School Year Scholar Statistics:

 Awarded \$98,336 to 37 scholars (21 returning and 16 new). After the 1st semester they average a 3.5 GPA!
