PHASED-IN REOPENING





FULL REOPENING

All schools will offer **REMOTE LEARNING** for the first 6 weeks

Devices will be provided to support all students with remote learning, along with support for home internet access

We will phase in a **HYBRID LEARNING ENVIRONMENT**

for specific grade levels/programs, with families that choose in-person learning.

Family engagement is critical as we determine what our hybrid learning environment will look like. All Red Clay families are asked to complete their school's Safe Return to School Questionnaire by Aug 24. More students will return to school for IN-PERSON LEARNING full-time as classroom restrictions are reduced

Some groups/programs may still utilize remote learning depending on building capacity.

Remote learning options will be available for families who are not ready to return to in-person learning in each phase

PHASE 1 // REMOTE LEARNING



6 weeks of remote learning starts on Sep 8!

- ★ Principals sent families a back-to-school letter with details about remote learning on Aug 18
- ★ Families are asked to complete their school's Safe Return to School questionnaire by Aug 24
- ★ Teachers will send families with a welcome letter with more class details by Aug 26
- ★ Families will receive their Red Clay Back-to-School Starter Kit in the mail on/around Aug 28-29
- ★ Chromebooks, elementary school supplies and other materials will be distributed at school
 Aug 31-Sep 4
- ★ Teachers will engage families online with a virtual "meet the teacher" activity in early September
