**1. HEARING, DEBATE, AND VOTE CONCERNING THE QUALIFICATIONS OF ERNEST
“TRIPPI” CONGO II TO SERVE AS COUNCIL MEMBER FOR THE 2ND DISTRICT
PURSUANT TO CHARTER SECTION 2-103.**

Section 2-103 provides that “[i]f a councilman shall cease to possess any of [the] qualifications, including in the case of a councilman elected from a councilmanic district, residence in the district from which he was elected. . . , his office shall immediately be forfeited and become vacant.” The section further provides that on demand a member charged with conduct constituting forfeiture of his office shall be entitled to a public hearing where City Council shall be the sole judge of the member’s qualifications.

The Question Presented for Yay or Nay Vote: Whether Ernest “Trippi” Congo at any time during the current session of City Council moved his residence to a location outside of the borders 2nd Councilmanic District he was representing, thereby immediately forfeiting his office as Council Member and rendering the District Vacant pursuant the Wilmington City Charter.
