WHEREAS, the Victims' Compensation Assistance Program was started in 1988 to help meet additional need incurred by victims of crime; and

WHEREAS, the Victims' Compensation Assistance Program provides compensation for funeral and burial cost to loss of support for victims of violence, and temporary housing to personal safety property; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 90, Title 11 of Delaware Code has not been updated to reflect the increased costs of funeral and burial, since its inception; and

WHEREAS, Wilmington residents who are secondary victims of crime as defined by Chapter 90, Title 11 of Delaware Code have experienced additional burden in recent years; and

WHEREAS, current rules restrict access to VCAP funds for the commission of a crime, that is often unrelated to the victim's reasons for applying for VCAP funds and contributes to the financial burden of the victim; and

WHEREAS, the current amount of funeral and burial assistance is no more than \$5,000 total; and

WHEREAS, the average cost of funeral and burial are levied between \$7,000 and \$12,000 which is difficult for many low-income families to afford.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY

OF WILMINGTON that the Delaware General Assembly is urged to increase amount of
