Council Member Oliver **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 2-308 and Section 8-200 of the City Charter, the City of Wilmington is authorized to enter into contracts for the supply of personal property or the rendering of services for a period of more than one year if approved by City Council by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City publicly advertised the specifications for Contract 22011PW "Gasoline, Heating Oil & Diesel Fuel" (the "Contract") in accordance with the requirements of Section 8-200 of the City Charter, and subsequently awarded the Contract, a copy of which, in substantial form, is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein as Exhibit "A", to James River Solutions (the "Contractor"), the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the delivered price per gallon for gasoline, heating oil, and diesel fuel that the City will pay to the Contractor under the Contract is comprised of two components - the daily OPIS Contract Low Rack price for Philadelphia, Pennsylvania at 5:00 p.m. for the day of delivery plus a delivery fee that is fixed for the term of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the term of the Contract is for the period from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, at an estimated price of Nine Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand, Five Hundred Fifty Eight Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$998,558.50), with the possibility of two (2) extensions of one (1) year thereafter with the same terms and conditions, at the option of the City, subject to budget appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the Contract is to provide fuel for the City's fleet of vehicles and heating oil for the City's buildings; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Department of Public Works that the City enter into the Contract with the Contractor for the period from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, and reserve the right to extend the Contract for two (2) additional periods of one (1) year thereafter, at the option of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON **HEREBY ORDAINS:**

SECTION 1. Contract 22011PW "Gasoline, Heating Oil & Diesel Fuel" between the City of Wilmington and James River Solutions, a copy of which Contract, in substantial form, is attached hereto as Exhibit "A," for the period from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, at an estimated price of Nine Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand, Five Hundred Fifty Eight Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$998,558.50), with the possibility of two (2) extensions of one (1) year thereafter with the same terms and conditions, at the option of the City, is hereby approved, and the Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute as many copies of the Contract, as well as to take all additional undertakings related thereto, as may be necessary.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by City Council and approval by the Mayor.



- 4. The successful bidder will be required to have or obtain an appropriate business license from the Department of Finance, Revenue Division, City of Wilmington, in order to be awarded the contract. Before obtaining a City of Wilmington Business License, all applicants must show proof of a current State of Delaware Business License.
- 5. The corporation, the successful bidder shall furnish a certificate from the State where it is incorporated, stating that it is a subsisting corporation. The corporation shall also furnish one (1) original and two (2) copies of the excerpts of the corporate minutes, which grant authority to those who sign and attest the contract. The Corporate Seal shall be affixed where signatures are attested.
- 6. The successful bidder will be required to withhold City of Wilmington Wage Tax from their employees and withheld taxes paid to the City of Wilmington pursuant to the provisions of the Wilmington Wage Tax Law. This law applies to people living and/or working in the City of Wilmington.
- 7. The U.S. Department of Commerce monitors Procurement transaction made to minority business enterprises by the City of Wilmington. The Minority Business Developments Agency's District Office reserves the right to contact the successful minority bidder and/or subcontractor to confirm any participation in the Procurement process.
- 8. The successful bidder certifies that they are not listed on the Federal Government, Excluded Parties List System (www.sam.gov). This will be verified by the City of Wilmington and if listed may be grounds for rejection of the bid or proposal.
- Any person doing business or seeking to do business with the City shall abide by the following <u>Global Sullivan</u> <u>Principles:</u>
 - A. Support universal human rights and particularly, those of employees, the communities within which you operate, and parties with whom you do business.
 - B. Promote equal opportunity for employees at all levels of the company with respect to issues such as color, race, gender, age, ethnicity, or religious beliefs, and operate without unacceptable worker treatment such as the exploitation of children, physical punishment, female abuse, involuntary servitude, or other forms of abuse.

10. Award and Execution of Contract

A. Consideration of Proposals. After the proposals are opened and read, they will be compared on the basis of the summation of the products of the approximate quantities shown in the bid schedule by the unit bid prices, unless the proposals states a different basis for comparing bids. In the event of a discrepancy between unit bid prices and extensions, the unit bid price shall govern.

Before awarding the contract, a bidder may be required to show that he/she has the ability, experience, necessary equipment, experienced personnel, and financial resources to successfully carry out the work required by the contract.

The right is reserved to reject any and/or all proposals, to waive technicalities, to advertise for new proposals, or to proceed to do the work otherwise, if in the judgment of the department the best interest of the City will be promoted thereby.

- B. Award of Contract. The award of the contract, if it be awarded, must be within thirty (30) calendar days after the opening of proposals to the lowest responsible and qualified bidder whose proposal complies with all the requirements prescribed. The successful bidder will be notified by letter mailed to the address shown on his proposals that his bid has been accepted and has been awarded the contract.
- C. Cancellation of Award. The City reserves the right to cancel the award of any contract at any time before the execution of said contract by all parties without any liability against the City.
- D. Right to Audit. The City Auditor or his designee shall have the right to audit the contract and any books, documents, or records relating thereto.

SPECIFICATIONS:

Petroleum products sold to the City of Wilmington under the Terms and Conditions of this contract will be tested according to the procedures and specifications outlined below. Vendors can bid Wagon Loads, Tanker Loads (8,500), or a combination of both:

Gasoline to conform to the ASTM Designation D439-79 or most current revision thereof; the antiknock requirement for gasoline shall be as follows:

Antiknock Index Minimum 87.0 octane Ethanol Content /Gal. Maximum 15%

Heating Oil to conform to the ASTM Designation for #2 Heating Oil, D396 or most current revision. The heating oil shall also comply with the requirement of Ultra Low Sulphur 15 PPM maximum. The City will not accept DYED ULSD in lieu of Heating Oil.

Diesel Fuel to conform to the ASTM designation D975 or most current revision for ULSD (12-15 PPM of Sulfur). Suppliers and their sources are prohibited from adulterating the fuel with reclaimed or waste products of any type. The fuel is to be completely distilled materials. That is, the fuel should show at least 98 percent of volume recovery when subjected to ASTM D-86 (or latest version) distillation. Fuel is to meet VVF-800 (grades DF-1 and DF-2) and ASTM Designation D-975. Fuel is to be clean and free of contamination of any kind. The cetane number rating must be a minimum of 40 and the final boiling point is to be 675 degrees Fahrenheit. The City will not accept 5% or 2% bio in your diesel.

TERM:

The initial term of this contract shall be July 1, 2021, or as soon as possible thereafter, to June 30, 2022. The City of Wilmington maintains the option to extend this contract for two (2) additional periods of one (1) year each which will run from July 1st until June 30th. Terms and conditions of the contract must remain the same. The City will give 60 days advanced written notice if the contract is to be extended.

PRICING METHOD:

For all fuel products the bidder must complete the proposal form at the end of this document. The delivered price per gallon of Gasoline / Heating Oil / Diesel Fuel will be calculated for each product as follows: the daily OPIS Contract Low Rack price for Philadelphia, PA at 5:00 pm for the day of delivery plus the delivery fee (fixed for the term of the contract) from the proposal form. The City of Wilmington is exempt from Federal and State excise taxes. Additional charges to appear separately on the invoice are:

Federal Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) Fee Federal Oil Spill Recovery Fee Delaware Hazard Substance Clean

A copy of the February 24, 2021 OPIS Contract Report for 5:00 pm is attached to this document for reference as Attachment A. Additionally, the base price on the proposal form is derived from the February 24, 2021 report. The prices on the proposal form are for comparison only. Invoiced pricing will fluctuate as detailed above.

ESTIMATED QUANTITIES:

The quantities stated in the attached proposal forms are used as basis of comparison of bids. Actual quantities purchased will be governed by need. The City reserves the right to change, add, or delete delivery locations within the City limits as needed.

TAXES:

The price quoted on all products shall be exempt from Federal, State, or local taxes. Tax exempt certificates will be supplied to the successful bidder(s) (license #21131)

GENERAL:

All Items of this specification shall meet or exceed Federal and /or State regulations with reference to air, water, storage, and pollution regulations. The initial term of this contract will be from date of signed contract to **June 30**, **202**2 with possible extensions as described above.

DELIVERY:

Delivery shall be made to the tanks at several locations, Monday through Friday, between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., and anytime when requested for an emergency delivery. When verbally ordered, normal delivery shall be made within 24 hours of receipt of the order.

The successful bidder shall supply a toll-free number where such orders may be placed. Should the successful bidder fail to make delivery of the fuel oil and the diesel or heating oil systems run out of fuel, he shall be liable for all the expenses for the repairs and maintenance to the equipment, including the expense of resetting the pumps restoring burners, cleaning nozzles, and ignition systems. Upon failure to deliver as requested, the City may at their discretion, arrange for another source of fuel oil and the vendor shall be liable for reimbursement to the City for any increase in costs resulting there from.

Emergency deliveries may be requested, and an after-hours delivery charge is to be entered on proposal sheet for this purpose.

Should any fuel delivered prove not to meet the specified standards, the successful bidder shall remove such fuel, replace with specified fuel, and bear the costs of the task. The successful bidder shall remove condensate and other foreign heavy material from the tanks as required, at no additional cost.

METERED DELIVERIES:

All fuel deliveries must be made by trucks equipped with a meter and printed tickets. The printed tickets must indicate readings before and after loading into storage tanks. Copies of the associated delivery tickets are to be sent with the invoices.

AUTOMATIC DELIVERIES:

The Successful Bidder must make automatic deliveries as required based on automatically faxed tank levels supplied daily by the City's Veeder Root System and the future deliveries are to be confirmed in advance with the City's designate by email (designate to be determined at bid award). Successful bidder shall supply a coordinating company contact individual to receive the subject City's tank level faxes. The automatic deliveries pertain to the 1450 New York Ave location fuel site at present but may include other locations later at the discretion of the City. SPECIFICATIONS:

Petroleum products sold to the City of Wilmington under the Terms and Conditions of this contract will be tested according to the procedures and specifications outlined below. Vendors can bid Wagon Loads, Tanker Loads (8,500), or a combination of both:

Gasoline to conform to the ASTM Designation D439-79 or most current revision thereof: the antiknock requirement for gasoline shall be as follows:

Antiknock Index Minimum 87.0 octane Ethanol Content /Gal. Maximum 15%

Heating Oil to conform to the ASTM Designation for #2 Heating Oil, D396 or most current revision. The heating oil shall also comply with the requirement of Ultra Low Sulphur 15 PPM maximum. The City will not accept DYED ULSD in lieu of Heating Oil.

Diesel Fuel to conform to the ASTM designation D975 or most current revision for ULSD (12-15 PPM of Sulfur). Suppliers and their sources are prohibited from adulterating the fuel with reclaimed or waste products of any type. The fuel is to be completely distilled materials. That is, the fuel should show at least 98 percent of volume recovery when subjected to ASTM D-86 (or latest version) distillation. GENERAL:

All Items of this specification shall meet or exceed Federal and /or State regulations with reference to air, water, storage, and pollution regulations. The initial term of this contract will be from date of signed contract to **June 30, 202**2 with possible extensions as described above.

DELIVERY:
