Programming Update

Programming is selected to benefit the overall City of Wilmington community. WITN provides video and audio content for two sectors: Government Programs and Community Programs. Our channel broadcasts live council meetings and proceedings, live mayoral events and announcements, public service announcements, emergency updates and an array of community events. In addition, our original television programs highlight the character of Wilmington's community and consist of the following:

- 2 Minute Drill: Is a program specifically made for Council Members. The platform allows for Wilmington City Council members to address their constituents directly on updates and important issues concerning their district and their city.
 Total 2 Minute Drill programs broadcasted between January 5 to May 31, 2021: 20
- 22News: Is our City of Wilmington's news program that features stories that directly affects Wilmington and Delaware residents, giving viewers more than just the basic facts, but also the context surrounding important events, our city, government, community issues, and more. - 22News On-the-Scene: This program allows viewers to see an event, press conference or announcement from start to finish that's held in the community. Each one is broadcasted "Live" on the scene. During the 108th Session of Wilmington City Council, the first 22News On-the-Scene program aired on April 22, 2021.

- **Budget Hearings:** Each year, members of the Wilmington City Council review the City's proposed budget, and during public, televised budget hearings, listen to presentations from each department and ask questions about proposed spending plans. All budget hearings can be viewed on our <u>www.witn22.org</u> website by clicking the "Programs" tab first, then the "Committees and Commissions" tab, then the "Finance and Economic Development" tab.



- Deputy Station Manager has continued the partnership developed during the 107th Session of Wilmington City Council between WITN and New Castle Council. New Castle Council will utilize WITN for the streaming of their Council meetings, and they are in the beginning stages of installing Swagit.
