2019-2020 Programming

September 2019 – August 2020 COVID crisis began March 2020

- 1,852 unique kids
 - school-sites, after-school, advanced weekly, hybrid summer
- > 94% free or reduced cost programming

2020-2021 Programming

September 2020 – August 2021 During COVID crisis

- > 373 unique kids
 - community centers, advanced weekly, full day summer
- 65% free or reduced cost programming
