WHEREAS, City Code Section 35-37(a) states that the “Wilmington Civil Rights Commission shall be composed of seven residents of the city[.]” and

WHEREAS, City Code Section 35-37(a) further states that the mayor shall appoint five members to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, Commissioners are subject to confirmation by resolution of city council, approved a majority of all members of the city council; and

WHEREAS, City Code Section 35-38(a) states that “members of the civil rights commission shall serve a three-year term. No member of the commission may serve more than two terms[.]” and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 20-048, on July 9, 2020, the Mayor appointed Brionna L. Denby, Esq. to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor wishes to reappoint Brionna L. Denby, Esq. for a second three-year term; and

WHEREAS, City Council deems it necessary and appropriate to confirm the reappointment of Brionna L. Denby, Esq. to the Wilmington Civil Rights Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON that the Council confirms the reappointment of Brionna L. Denby, Esq. to the Wilmington Civil Rights Commission.
