WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-363 of the City Code, City Council deemed it necessary and proper to specify the requirements for review and approval of City-sponsored grant applications and proposals, including authorization for expedited grant applications when necessary prior to Council's approval by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Wilmington Police Department has submitted a grant application to the State of Delaware Special Law Enforcement Assistance Fund in the amount of \$70,000; and

WHEREAS, proposed grant funding in the amount of \$18,000 would allow for the purchase of an Event Data Recorder, which will enable investigators to download crucial information from Hyundai and Kia vehicles following fatal, near-fatal, and other serious motor vehicle collisions; and

WHEREAS, proposed grant funding in the amount of \$52,000 would allow for the purchase of 20 new LifePak 1000 Automatic External Defibrillators. These would replace aging devices that are no longer functioning and are outside of warranty coverage. These devices are carried in patrol cars to serve as an immediate tool to revive someone suffering from sudden cardiac arrest or other emergency medical conditions that can benefit from the use of an AED; and

WHEREAS, this grant funding would cover expenses that would otherwise have to be paid for out of the Police Department's annual operating budget, thereby continuing the Police Department's efforts to identify funding opportunities to negate increases to the City's annual operating budget; and

WHEREAS, no matching funds are required; and

WHEREAS, City Council deems it necessary and proper to authorize the grant application for the aforesaid purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON that the Wilmington Police Department's grant application to the State of Delaware Special Law Enforcement Assistance Fund in the total amount of \$70,000 is hereby authorized.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of Police, or designee, shall be authorized to take all necessary actions to accept any and all funds associated with the grant application and to fulfill the grant requirements.

SYNOPSIS: This Resolution authorizes the Wilmington Police Department's grant application to the State of Delaware Special Law Enforcement Assistance Fund in the amount of \$70,000. The proposed grant funds would be used to purchase an Event Data Recorder for use during investigations into serious vehicle collisions, as well as 20 new Automatic External Defibrillators that would be carried in patrol vehicles and available for use by officers who encounter someone suffering from sudden cardiac arrest or other emergency medical conditions. No local matching funds are required.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT: There is no negative fiscal impact to the City because no local matching funds are required by this grant.
