Council Member Darby WHEREAS, the Wilmington City Council allocates public funds for members and staff to attend conferences, training, and government-related travel with the intent of gaining knowledge and best practices to benefit the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of transparency, and accountability, the public should be informed about how city resources are being used for travel and what benefits result from said expenditures; and

WHEREAS, requiring Councilmembers who travel on city-funded expenses to provide a report and public presentation ensures that the knowledge gained contributes to policymaking, governance improvements, and city initiatives.

WHEREAS, in light of the foregoing, City Council deems it necessary and appropriate to amend City Council Rules to create a requirement that presentations are provided to the Intergovernmental Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON that the City Council Rules are hereby amended by creating a new Rule 10-3 to read as follows:

RULE 10-2 – COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

RULE 10-3 – TRAVEL REPORTING REQUIREMENT

Any Council member seeking to travel using city funds must submit a post-travel public report and presentation to Council's Intergovernmental Committee at the next available public meeting regarding the purpose and details of their trip.
