Synopsis:

This Ordinance is being presented by the Administration for Council's review and approval. This Ordinance temporarily suspends the issuance of business licenses pursuant to City Code Section 5-36 for "retail marijuana stores," as defined in Title 4, Section 1302 of the Delaware Code, for a period of ninety (90) days while the City determines how to amend the Zoning Code regarding recreational marijuana-related uses and/or whether to amend Chapter 5 of the City Code to prohibit retail marijuana stores.
