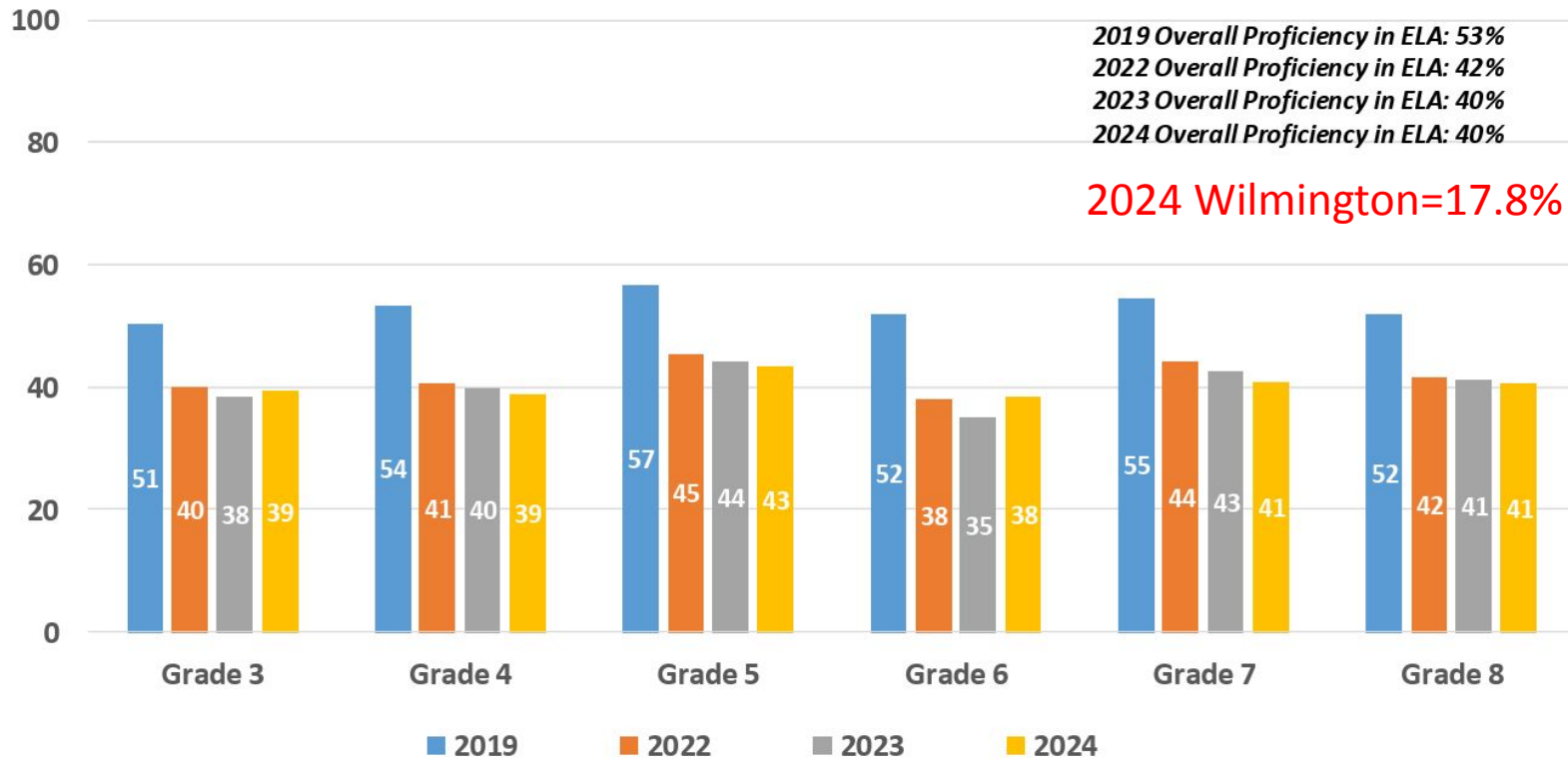


# State 8<sup>th</sup> grade went 45%-41%= -6%

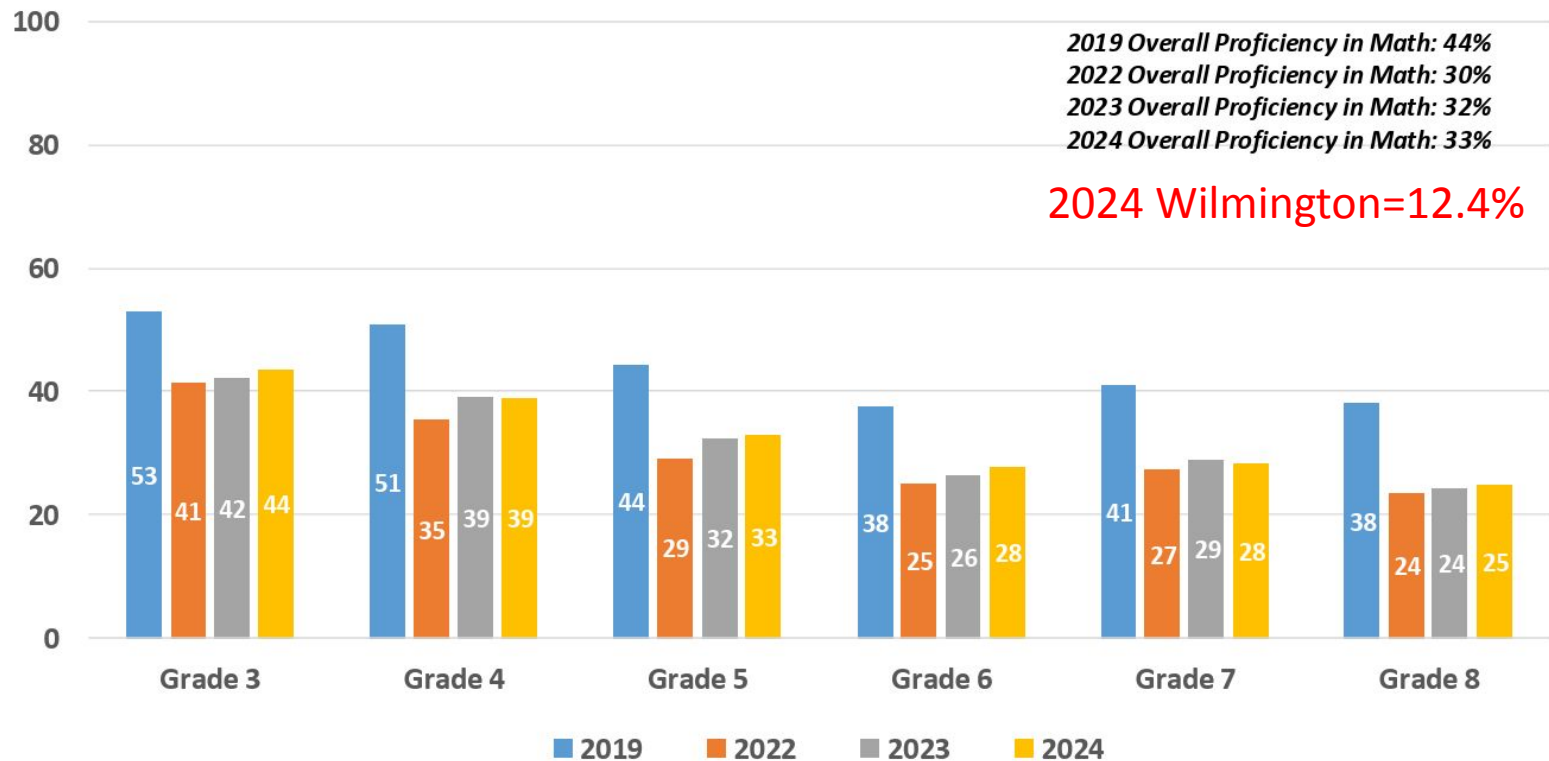


# State 8<sup>th</sup> grade went 25% to 25%=0%

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# Student Programming

- Program Partners
  - Our program partner **FLUXSPACE** has been on board since March providing instruction and training to the students. We are completing certification modules for teachers who once certified will be able to conduct instruction in the space independent of FLUX. **We are also assisting with getting FLUXSPACE in front of other schools and community centers.**
  - **Future First Gaming (FFG)** has been on board since January providing coding and gaming instruction for Eastside students in our after school program. Matt Johnson who is on staff here at Eastside and is also a professional gamer is contracted with FFG to assist the students with navigating the games for competitions, learning the variety of career that exist in gaming and the basics of coding.
  - **DETV** has developed a curriculum scheduled to begin in the Fall. They are starting to set the studio up this summer and test all the equipment. Interest flyers will go out to the parents/students this summer.
  - We have partnered with **Code Differently** to provide a (4) week Drone coding camp which will be held here at Eastside in the Maker Space.
  - We are once again partnering with **Kingswood Community Center** to offer summer camp. (5) Eastside teachers will be providing academic support this summer and the camp is free to Eastside students.
  - (14) 8<sup>th</sup> graders completed a **coding program with Exelon**
  - **BloominGALS** is a teen mentoring program for girls ages 13-18. They hold sessions at Eastside for (6) consecutive Thursday's and assists with etiquette, developing self confidence, public speaking, social/emotional wellness and team building.



# Adult Programming

- Adult Programming/Workforce Development
  - The first cohort of training with our partnership with **DelTech** resulted in (19) students getting certified in: phlebotomy, certified nursing assistant, emergency medical technician and dialysis technician. (2) of the students were Eastside parents. Thus far, (6) of the (19) students have received job placement. DelTech is working with site partners for the others. We were under budget in our allocations and have requested that the State approve us to partner with 'NERDit Now' to provide training, certification and placement for (8) students seeking a career in computer maintenance.
  - **Cinnaire/Jump Start** is conducting their current 'Developer' training here at Eastside. Jump Start trains minorities interested in careers as real estate developers.
  - **BioConnect DE** will be offering life sciences and manufacturing training here at Eastside beginning in June. Two information sessions were held at the STEM Hub and the program has received over 120 applications for the first cohort of (25) seats.
  - We are working with **Code Differently to assist with promoting their Software Developer program** which provides free 20 week certification for Software Developers. The partnership allows us to develop our CRM and provide information to families seeking additional information in programs we are offering.
  - **Chemours** is designing a workforce development program for adults seeking lab research certifications.
  - **DelTech** has designed a program for Financial Technology (FINTECH) that will assist adults with managing money, budgets, credit, save, invest and be informed about processes involved in purchasing a home. We are currently looking at sponsorship/partnership opportunities to pay the cost of approximately \$2,800.00 per person.
  - **TTW Church** who now leases our auditorium on Sundays is also providing several programs in the STEM Hub which are open to the community.
