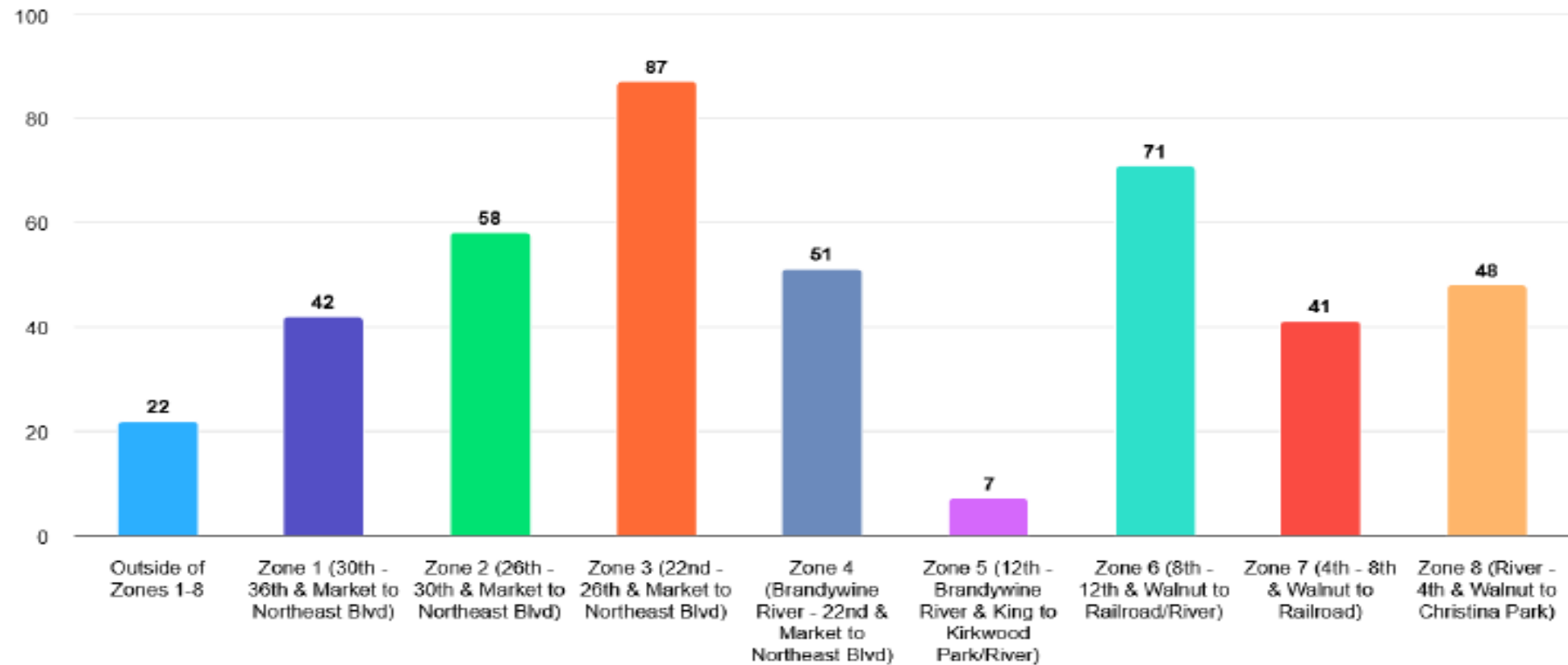

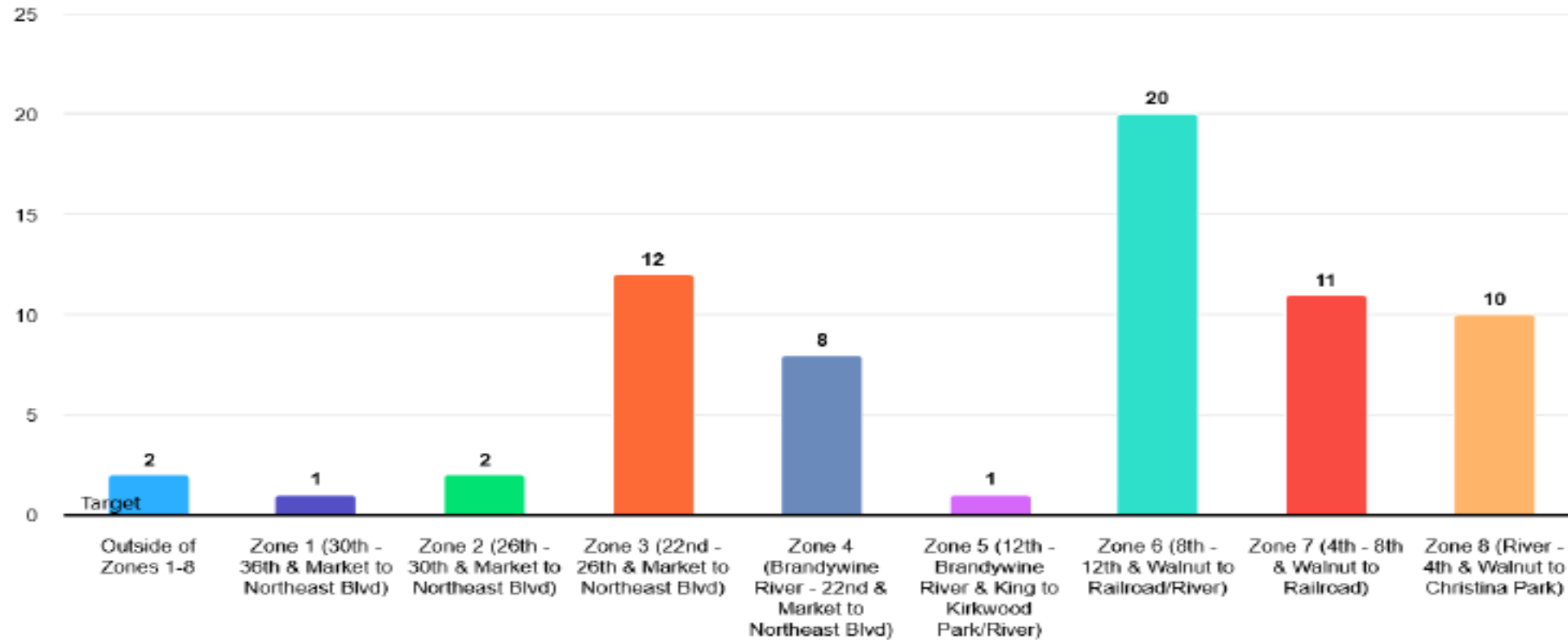

HUBS

- 914 N. Pine Street – East Side HUB
- 2214 N. Market Street – North Side HUB
- **East Side HUB**
 - During the first quarter of 2025, more than 120 bus passes were distributed, 109 people received clothing, and more than 600 meals were served. The HUB also provided diapers for nearly 30 people. Twenty-one (21) community members took showers, and more than 60 loads of clothes were washed.
- **North Side HUB**
 - During the first quarter, 578 meals were provided, seven (7) people took showers, Narcan kits were distributed in the surrounding area, and numerous community members were provided clothing. Individuals also received diapers when needed and referrals to other agencies.
