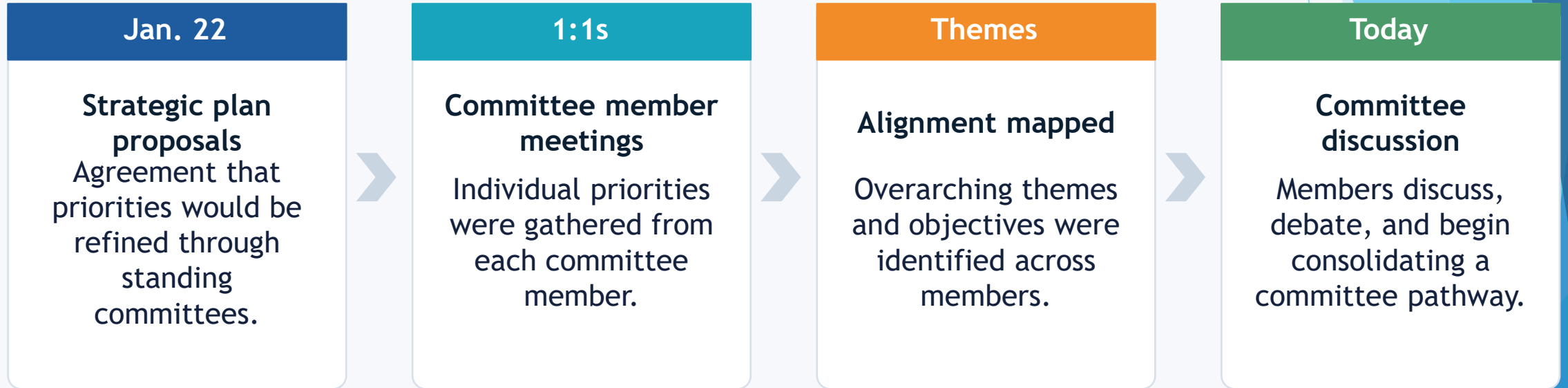

Homelessness Response & Coordination

Chair

- ▶ Expand permanent supportive housing and improve coordination of shelter resources to address homelessness.

Committee Members

- ▶ Develop a clearer understanding of the City's homelessness strategy, available resources and coordination efforts.
- ▶ Receive regular reporting on homelessness related efforts and outcomes.

Senior Well-Being & Support

Chair

- ▶ Strengthen oversight of senior housing conditions through rental inspections for senior high-rise buildings.
- ▶ Explore creation of a senior check-in program in partnership with WPD to support elderly residents living independently.

Committee Members

- ▶ Build a stronger understanding of challenges facing seniors.
- ▶ Review participation and outcomes of senior focused programs such as the senior tax credit and examine overlapping financial burdens.
- ▶ Expand opportunities for senior socialization and engagement through Citywide programming, community-based activities, and listening sessions with seniors in high-rises.
- ▶ Create stronger intergenerational programs connecting seniors and youth through mentorship, shared activities, and skill-building opportunities.
- ▶ Continue oversight of living conditions, property management responsiveness, and support services in senior high-rises.

Community Health & Outreach

Chair

- ▶ Promote food justice and neighborhood sustainability initiatives including community gardens and local food access programs.

Committee Members

- ▶ Expand public education and outreach regarding healthcare access, insurance changes, and enrollment options.
- ▶ Encourage public facing healthcare awareness efforts through fairs, education campaigns, and neighborhood-based outreach.
