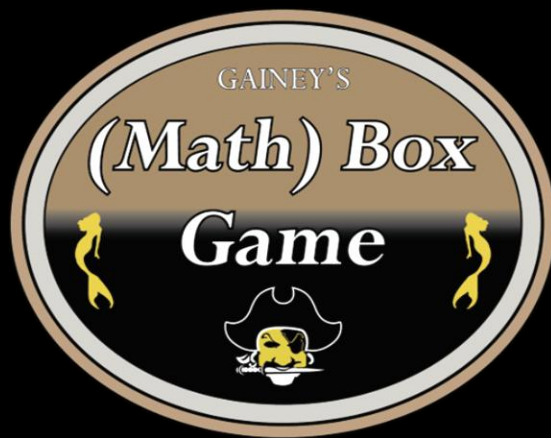


ICONS OF MUSIC BOARD GAME

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Icons of Music Borad Game Rules

1. Using your pawn, place it on the block that indicates where to start at the top right corner block.
2. Toss the dice.
3. Move the total number of spaces on the dice face up after the toss. Begin the game at the start location and move right to left.
4. When you land on a block, you must answer the following 2 out of 3 questions correctly to continue to move forward.
 - a) You must identify the artist in the photo that you landed on.
 - b) Give a brief description of their historical significance.
 - c) Give the timeframe when they achieved their historical significance within a 10-year timeframe.
5. if the player cannot successfully answer the 2 out of 3 questions, then they must pick a card from the deck of cards
 - a) if the player cannot identify from one of the photos on the board from the description given on the card, then the player loses their turn until next round.
 - b) if the player cannot answer correctly to identify or answer correctly from the card description, the player not only ends his turn for the moment, but they also must move back three places.
6. Once the player goes around the board one full-time, they must turn around and go back the other way and continue to play until they reach back at or beyond the starting block.
7. The game is over once the first game player reaches back to the starting block.
8. When landing on the “Music Session” block on the board, the player must pick a card and identify the answer with selecting the correct photo on the board from the description given.

1. Michael Jackson

R&B artist and actor. He is known as the “King of Pop”. He was vital with transforming, videos, dance and performances around the world. One of his signature songs is, “Billie Jean”.

2. Frankie Beverly

R&B singer and artist and native of Philadelphia. Formed the group Frankie Beverly and Maze. Well known songs, “Before I let Go”, and “Joy and Pain”

3. Billie Holiday

Jazz vocalist, during the 1930s–1950s. Well known songs, “Lady Day” and “Good Morning Heartache”.

4. Sam Cooke

R&B singer with gospel roots from 1957–1964. He was also an activist, killed at the hands of a black hotel manager. One of his signature songs is, “A Change is Gonna Come”.

5. Prince

R&B and Funk solo singer, artist, musician and composer. His style was flamboyant, and he was a multi-instrumentalist. His voice was in a high-pitched range. Signature songs, “1999”, “Little Red Corvette” and “ Purple Rain”.

6. Eminem

Rapper artist and actor. His music is full of storytelling, complex emotions, One of his signature songs was “Lose Yourself”

7. Madonna

Singer, artist and actress with fashion-forward performances and with vocal and dance versatility Well known song: “Like a Virgin”.

8. Duke Ellington

Jazz pianist and composer, with orchestra leadership during 1924 onward. He was part of the Harlem Renaissance.

9. Marvin Gaye

Socially conscious R&B singer and songwriter. Many of his songs were full of social and political conscience driven messages. Well known song, “What’s Going On”.

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10. Louis Armstrong

Jazz musician with technical brass mastery. Iconic personality known as ‘Satchmo’, because of his puffed-out cheeks while playing.

11. James Brown

R&B solo artist, singer who was one of the greatest performers with his powerful dancing and singing. Many of his songs were socially conscience messages. His well-known songs are, “I’m Black and I’m Proud, and The Big Payback”,

12. Stevie Wonder

R&B singer, artist and composer. He brought social issues to the forefront. 2 of his well-known songs are, “Happy Birthday, and Superstition”.

13. Whitney Houston

R&B solo singer, artist, actor and model. She was known as, “The Voice” One of her well-known songs was “The Greatest Love of All”

14. Phyllis Hyman

R&B and Jazz solo singer and artist. Her theme was tailored with a soulful delivery, improvisation, and powerful connection with the audience. One of her signature songs is “Meet Me on the Moon”.

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16. The Beatles

An English rock band formed in 1960. Considered by most, the best band in western popular music and certainly one of the best international bands during their time. Famous song "A Hard Days Night".

17. Beyoncé

The most awarded female singer - artist of all time, sold over 20 million records worldwide, deemed one of the greatest influential talents of all time. famous song, "Baby Boy". She embraces R&B and soul.

18. Scott Joplin

From 1868 to 1917 American pianist and composer dubbed the king of ragtime, made more than 40 ragtime pieces. His death marked the end of the ragtime era.

19. Frank Sinatra

American singer and actor who rose to prominence in the 1940s. Known as "Ol' Blue Eyes, and Chairmen of the Board". His performances were smooth vocals. One of the most popular and bestselling entertainers of the 20th century.

20. Taylor Swift

Singer and influential figure in popular culture. known for her autobiographical songs, writing and artistic, reinventions. Highest grossing live music artist.

21. Nina Simone

Singer, songwriter, pianist and civil rights activist and performed jazz, blues, and folk music. She became friends with Malcolm X and Martin Luther King. Her famous song: "Mississippi Goddamn", became an anthem for the civil rights movement.

22. Patti LaBelle

Famous R&B singer and actress whose career spans over 7 decades. She has sold over 50 million records and is known as "the godmother of soul." Grammy Hall of Famer and recognized for her vocal power.

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23. **Bruce Springsteen**

Singer, songwriter, nicknamed, “The Boss”, socially conscious lyrics that reflect the working-class American life. One of his well-known songs is, “Born in the USA”.

24. **Jimi Hendrix**

Guitarist, R&B singer and songwriter, regarded as one of the greatest guitarist of all time, rock ‘n’ roll Hall of Famer. Favorite songs, “Foxy Lady”, and “Purple Haze”

25. **Teddy Pendergrass**

Soul and R&B singer and songwriter. His car crashed and he was paralyzed in 1982. Many years later he died from respiratory failure. One of his well-known songs, is “Close the Door”. He had a massive popularity which sold out audiences.

26. **Nat King Cole**

Jazz and R&B pianist and actor. He faced intense, racial discrimination. He was also a member of the NAACP and participated in the 1963 March on Washington. He had the first nationally broadcast show by a black American, called, “The Nat King Cole Show”. One of his well-known songs is “Unforgettable”.

27. **Kendrick Lamar**

Rapper, singer, songwriter, and record producer. Regarded as one of the greatest rappers of all time and in 2018 post surprise for music conscious. One of his famous songs is, “They Not Like Us”.

28. **Ray Charles,**

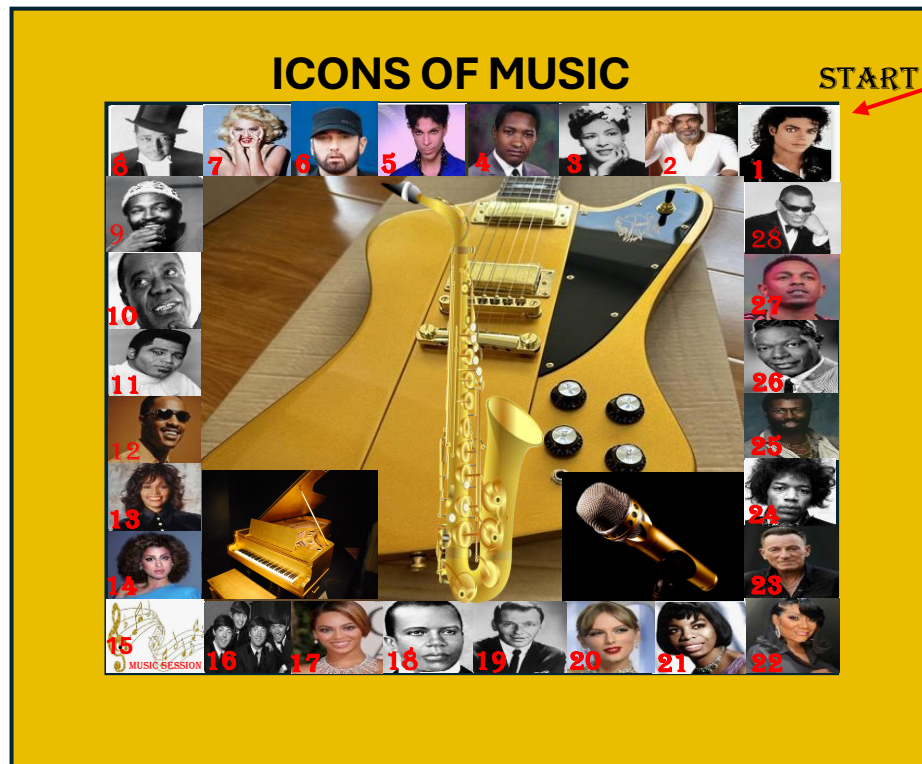
R&B, Soul and Jazz, Singer, songwriter, pianist, and one of the most iconic and influential musicians in history, known as the ‘genius’. He was blinded during childhood, possibly due to Glaucoma. Well-known song of his is, “Georgia on My Mind”.
